The wall segment is attached to the far side of first boulder and split stone creating an integrated enclosure. From that point onward the wall is a double wide wall with small stone fill.

Potential feature on opposite side of wall. Parallel long stones about two feet apart jut out from the elongated outcrop. They do not abut the outcrop. There is a high potential this is a feature: enclosure? spirit portal? It appears to have been altered by man.

Sketch of beginning of the wall at the outcop and parallel stones feature












