

- The serpentine line of stones makes contact with the boulder (effigy) midway along its length. The curved out section forms an enclosure 5' across.
- Adjacent to the boulder's end with the protrusion (serpent's head) is a small pool of water
- The structure is likely a double serpent connected with water. The enclosure was used by a person, probably the shaman leading the ceremony. It was a way for the shaman to make contact with the serpent.

Cairns in close proximity to the wall contain similar type and size of stones used in the wall. The fact they are still there shows the cairns were not used as a source of stone for the wall. This was determined by the logic that the cairns closest to the wall would have been

the first to be used had these stone piles been built as storage piles for the wall. The fact they are still intact indicates these cairns were left alone by the wall builders or that they were built after the wall was built. At Casco Bay Maine the Euro-Americans respected the Two Brothers Cairns built to commemorate a peace treaty by the whites and Indians. Is this what happened here at Canonchet? Did the white settlers know about and respect the Native American ceremonial cairns by avoiding them and not using the stones in them?






